Saturday 23rd June 9.30am – 4pm Myers-Briggs Introductory Workshop

- Ever wondered why people look at the world differently?
- Why you understand some people well and don't understand others at all?
- Why you get on well with some people and not with others?
- Why some people talk a lot and others say far less?
- Why some thrive on change and others find change really hard?

If you have wondered about the diverse and often amazingly different ways that people important to you, or just people around you, seem to look at the world or react to situations, the MBTI will interest you. If you have a problem understanding or communicating with someone you care about – a parent, a child, a co-worker, or someone else – the MBTI may be just what you have been looking for.

The Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI) is a tool for learning more about ourselves and those around us. During the workshop we will look at our uniqueness, and at the similarities that we often share.

The workshop will be run by Rev Sandy Matheson who is a qualified Myers-Briggs Practitioner.

There will be a charge of £25 with all proceeds going to support the St Paul's Building Fund. Bring your own lunch, drinks will be provided.
